- **This year all video and photo entries should be uploaded onto a media sharing website a link to which must be emailed to mjsuggate@gmail.com by 10AM on Sunday morning.**
- In the creativity section, points awarded will be based upon effort and all submissions must clearly state your unit name.
- In the collect section, all items must be placed in a box clearly stating your unit name.
- All the photographs are at the end of the question sheet.
- Please arrive with your answers to The Training Centre, **YOULBURY** on Sunday 24th November between **14:00 and 14:45**. After this time you will be docked a point per minute late.
- To celebrate 50 years of the Doctor your answers are to be delivered by the man (or woman) himself and at least 2 of his arch enemies from down the years. Teams not meeting this criterion or not making enough effort will be deducted up to five points from their total score!

There are 50 questions in total with a maximum score of 100 available.

To obtain full marks, you do not have to do anything illegal, dangerous or even immoral, but please remember to use common sense at all times and keep a watchful eye on fellow team members.

In the event of a tie-break, the team with the largest pair of wood beads, made from wood and in perfect proportion to a standard set of beads will be declared the victors!

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Section Two: Upload

In this section you must upload all films and photos onto a media sharing website and email the link to view them to mjsuggate@gmail.com by 10AM Sunday morning for judging. We **will not** be marking any entries made on laptops or cameras at Youlbury.

The website you use is up to you, but please ensure you give yourself enough time to perform the upload, especially for films. Also, the longer the film, the longer the upload time (and in my experience, it is not proportional) therefore if you wish to upload a long film in multiple shorter sections, this is perfectly fine.

Unless otherwise stated all **PHOTOS** should include 2 unit members who must be identifiable by wearing your unit scarf.

11. Take a photo of a fully pitched tent in a sporting arena [3]
12. Make a “movie style” trailer for your unit [4]
13. Make a film with 3 unit members travelling on one micro scooter in “wing formation” for at least 5 seconds. [2]
14. Take a photo of your unit making a human Stonehenge [2]
15. Film your unit performing a rendition of the campfire song “*I Like Traffic Lights*” next to a busy set of traffic lights [2]
16. Photograph a unit member with a waiter/owner from restaurants of the following cuisines: Indian, Chinese, Italian, Persian, Japanese and Russian [4]
17. Film your unit travelling between Boswells and Carfax Tower within 120 seconds between 13:00 and 13:10 on Saturday afternoon as a “4 legged team” (i.e. 3 unit members with two legs tied to each other by the ankles). NOTE – any teams interfering with the progress of another team will have 10 marks removed! [4]
18. Photograph a re-creation of the film poster to “Despicable Me 2” (the one with 9 minions on a blue background) using unit members [2]
19. Take a “Hadouken” photo using unit members [1]
20. Take a photo of one of your unit with a “cat beard” [1]



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21. Film your unit performing an interpretive dance to the Bonny Tyler classic "*Holding Out for a Hero*" [4]
 22. Take a photo with the "butcher" in Photo A [1]
- Take a photo of one of your unit members in the following scenarios with the required professional:
23. Being "cuffed by a copper" [2]
 24. Having their pulse taken by a nurse [2]
 25. Being "put out" by a fireman [2]

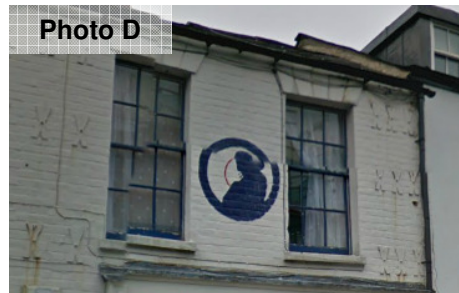
